

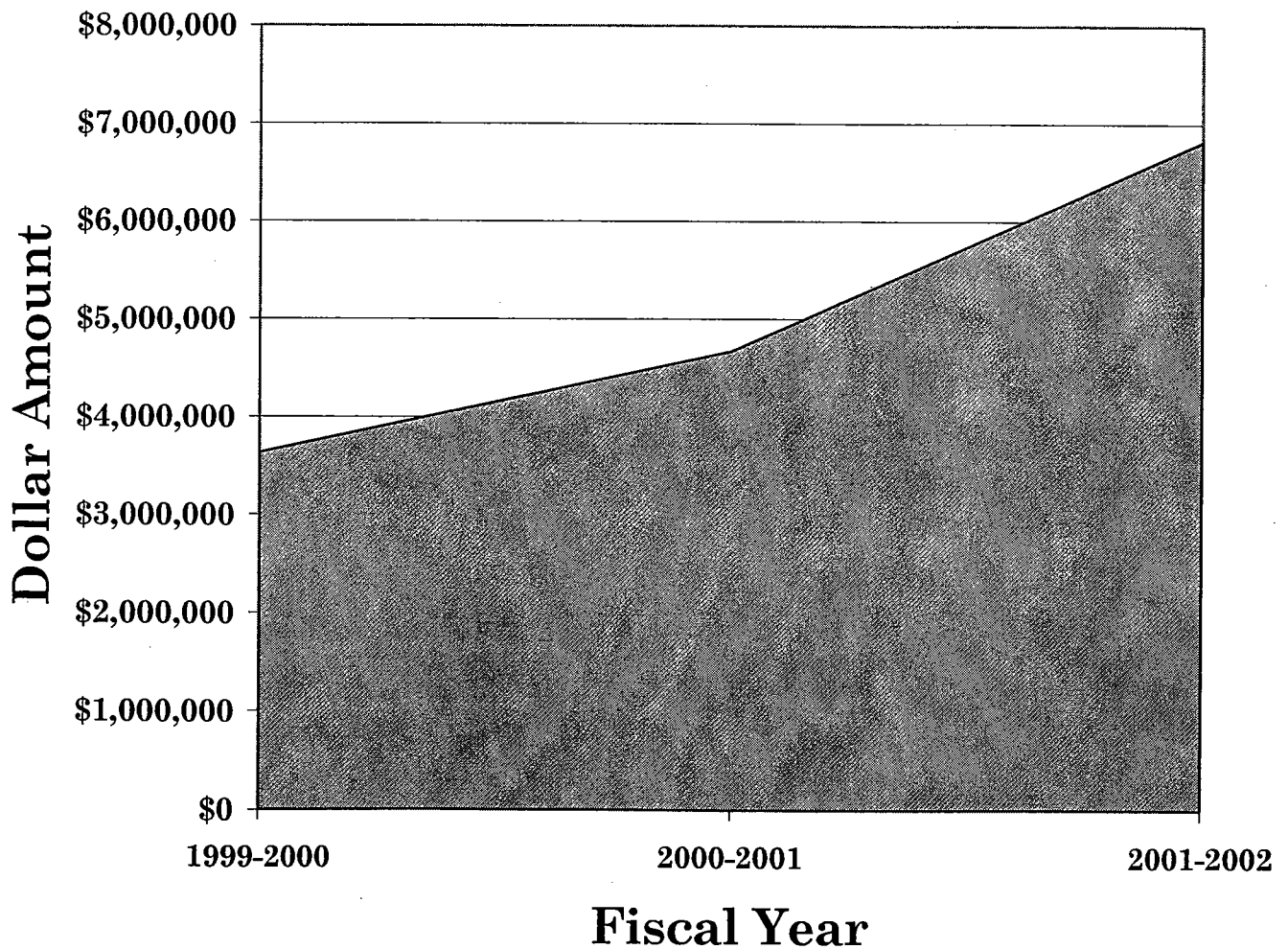

Our Numbers are Growing!

From the Vice Provost for Research and Faculty Development

Indeed, we are growing! Two years ago when we began this journey, our goal was to build a responsive research enterprise to promote, enhance and sustain faculty grantsmanship and scholarship. Our premise was that we needed a supportive and reliable infrastructure to form the basis of the reinvention of the Office of Academic Grants and Sponsored Research. We are glad to report that two years later, we are almost there! We have added PotoSSA to SOSA, and reconstituted the Institutional Review Board. We have, also, consolidated research administrative processes into a "one-stop shop" That is, faculty, staff or students seeking information on funding opportunities or implementing a grant or contract award only need to make *one stop* at OAGSR. Effective September 3 2002, financial reporting on all sponsored programs will be added to the function of OAGSR to complete the "cradle to grave" model of research administration from idea development to closeout.

As reflected in this annual summary report for FY02, total grant awards increased by 46% from FY01 or by 85% from FY00. This rate of increase puts us ahead of our goal to increase dollars awarded by 25% annually. In addition to this increase, TCNJ faculty are making inroads in the very competitive national grants area. The number of federal awards to TCNJ in fiscal year 2002 is nearly triple the number awarded in 2001. Of particular note are the research and instrumentation awards from the National Science Foundation: one for computer science research, two for engineering research instrumentation (CCLI and MRI), one NSF economics research award, and a Fulbright Alumni Initiative Award for program development. We congratulate everyone who developed proposals in FY02.

We also congratulate faculty compet-

ing every year for SOSA awards. This institutionally sponsored scholarship serves as the primary means of support for a considerable number of faculty. Since we are often unable to meet all SOSA requests yearly, we strongly encourage faculty to explore non-institutional sources of support at OAGSR using the InfoEd funding opportunities and e-mail alert database. The pre award specialist, Roberta Truscello, is ready and eager to assist faculty in searching the InfoEd database of more than 10,000 sponsor programs covering all disciplines and subjects, and federal, foundations and other private sources of funding.

We are reporting, for the first time, revenues generated from entrepreneurial initiatives of faculty, staff, departments, schools, or programs. The categories of these enterprise funds include contract courses and training programs; equipment and supplies; workshop and conference registrations; publications, subscriptions and advertisements; and fees for service. Also, for the first time, we have included the projects supported through the mini grant program re-established in FY02.

New initiatives are underway in the area of support for research. A faculty working group, with administrative support from Angela Sgroi of OAGSR, will take on the task of identifying how we can promote student research at TCNJ. They will tap resources from CUR (Council on Undergraduate Research) and other resources to help chart a course of action to expand student research on campus. Other ideas under consideration include finding a way to establish collegial support for faculty research through school or departmental round tables, and perhaps to

establish networks to help translate feedback from internal and external research grant proposals into stronger proposals.

Finally, we are pleased to announce the piloting of our "home grown" ER-SPA. Please use it to develop and process proposals and to report your sponsored programs outcomes. We hope to be able to share with you some of the accomplishments from these reports.

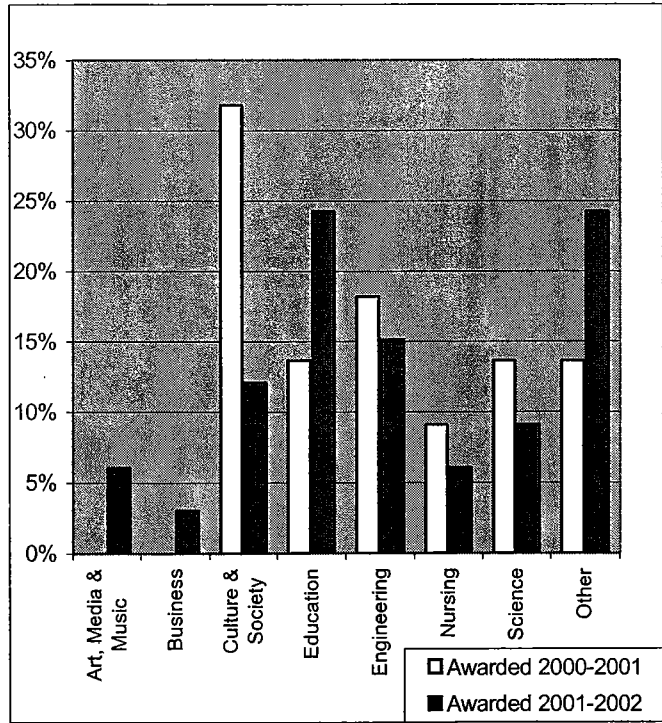
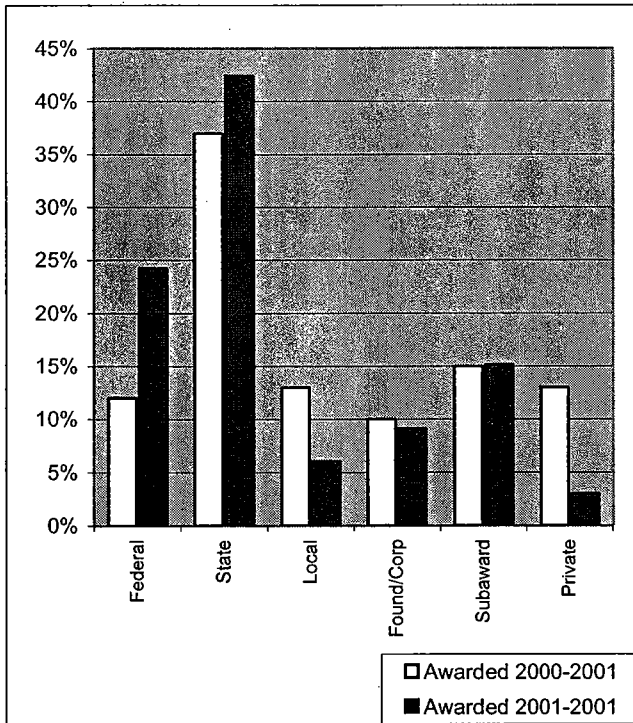
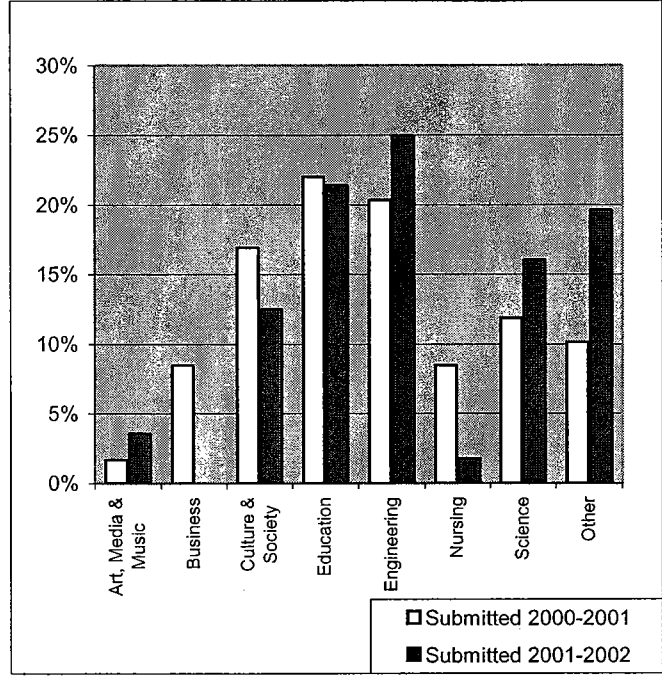
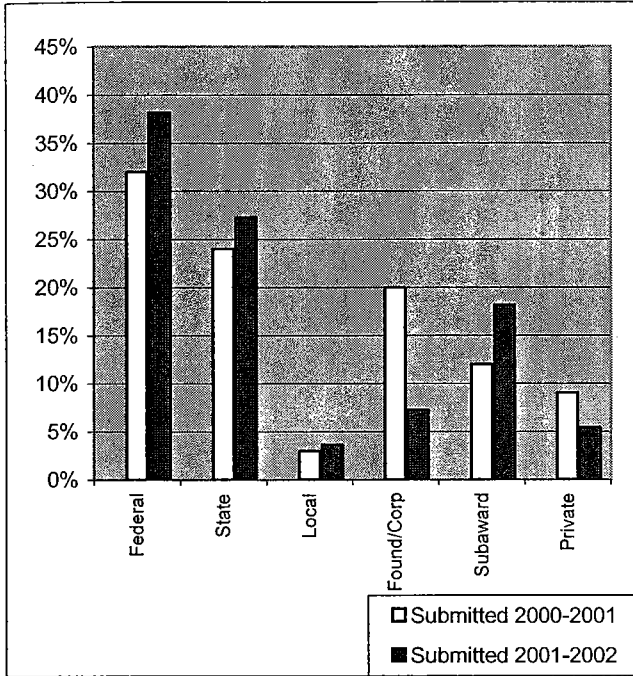

Grants On Line--ERSPA is Here!

Electronic Research and Sponsored Programs Assistant (ERSPA) is ready to provide proposal preparation assistance at your electronic fingertips. Are you just beginning to get your thoughts together for a proposal you intend to submit to a specific funding agency? Then complete the Early Notification - Intent to Submit a Proposal Form. This will alert the people in OAGSR of your intention and enable us to support you through the entire process of proposal preparation.

Creating a proposal budget used to be a headache for many. But ERSPA's Budget Template is like having a miniature accountant in your computer. It will ask you all of the necessary budget questions and guide you through the budget process, computing for you as it goes.

Basic information about the College such as fringe benefit rates and F&A (Facilities and Administration) rates are built in and are automatically calculated for you. Viewing options allow you view and print the budget in summary form or itemized form.

And completing the Routing/Approval Form is now a breeze. Once your budget has been approved by OAGSR (electronically, of course), all of the information from the budget automatically populates corresponding sections of the Routing/Approval Form. It leaves only a few easy check boxes for you to complete before attaching your proposal narrative and submitting it for approval to your chair, dean, and OAGSR.

We have to warn you, however, that, like most innovations, even though this program offers new options, others are lost. For example, exercise opportunities are diminished when you use this program because you no longer need to run from office to office getting signatures on your Routing/Approval Form. We can suggest alternatives, like playing some music and dancing around your office while you wait for your electronic responses.

To access ERSPA, go to the OAGSR website (<http://grants.intrasun.tcnj.edu/>) and scroll down to ERSPA. Also available to you through ERSPA is access to the Sponsored Programs Outcomes form (SPO). Work is continuing on the Post Award components of ERSPA. We'll keep you posted.
