- Complete the Learner Registration steps by entering your information.

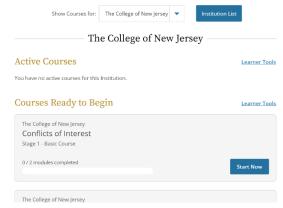
## TO ACCESS COURSES AND WEBINARS
